8 Relating to Jefferson County; to amend Act 99-594 of  
9 the 1999 Regular Session (Acts 1999, p. 1363), relating to the  
10 pistol permit fee the sheriff is required to charge, to  
11 specify the distribution of the fee to the Jefferson County  
12 Legislative Delegation Fund; to provide that a portion of any  
13 current balance shall be distributed to the public schools;  
14 and to repeal any conflicting laws.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

16 Section 1. Section 2 of Act 99-594 of the 1999  
17 Regular Session, (Acts 1999, p. 1363), is amended to read as  
18 follows:

19 "Section 2. In Jefferson County, the total fee for  
20 issuance of a permit to carry a pistol as provided by Section  
21 13A-11-75, Code of Alabama 1975, shall be seven dollars and  
22 fifty cents (\$7.50) per year. The fee shall be paid by the  
23 sheriff to the county treasurer and the county treasurer shall  
24 distribute the seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50) as  
25 follows:

1           "(1) Four dollars and fifty cents (\$4.50) shall be  
2 distributed to the retirement system established by Act 551 of  
3 the 1953 Regular Session or its successor.

4           "(2) Fifty cents (\$.50) shall be distributed to the  
5 Jefferson County Sheriff's Fund.

6           "(3) Two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50) shall be  
7 distributed to a fund in the county treasury designated the  
8 Jefferson County Legislative Delegation Office Fund to be  
9 further distributed as provided herein. Any amounts previously  
10 distributed and not expended pursuant to this subdivision  
11 shall be transferred to the fund. Any amounts in the fund over  
12 one hundred twenty thousand dollars (\$120,000) on the  
13 effective date of the act amending this subdivision shall  
14 thereafter be distributed to the public school systems in the  
15 county to be used for the operation of the pubic schools,  
16 including, but not limited to, being used for school security,  
17 on a pro rata basis based on the number of school students in  
18 each school system to the total number of students in the  
19 county based on enrollment numbers for the 2013-2014 school  
20 year as reported to the State Department of Education. Of this  
21 ~~amount two~~ ~~The remaining balance in the fund and any amounts~~  
22 ~~accruing thereafter may be expended as follows: Two dollars~~  
23 ~~(\$2) or the portion needed thereof shall may be spent for the~~  
24 ~~operation of the legislative office located in Birmingham, and~~  
25 ~~fifty cents (\$.50) shall may be used for the operation of the~~  
26 ~~legislative office located in Bessemer."~~

1           ~~Of this amount two dollars (\$2)~~ The remaining  
2 balance in the fund and any amounts accruing pursuant to this  
3 subdivision after the distribution provided in the preceding  
4 sentence or the portion needed thereof shall be spent for the  
5 operation of ~~the~~ a legislative office located in Birmingham,  
6 ~~and fifty cents (\$.50) shall be used for the operation of the~~  
7 ~~legislative office located in Bessemer.~~

8           Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict  
9 with this act are repealed. Act 323, 1963 Regular Session  
10 (Acts 1963, p. 803) and Act 97-280 of the 1997 Regular Session  
11 (Acts 1997, p. 500), as amended, are expressly repealed.

12           Section 3. This act shall become effective  
13 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
14 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
