HOUSE COMMITTEE OF REFERENCE AMENDMENT

Committee on State, Civic, Military, & Veterans Affairs.

HB26-1126 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 3, strike line 2 and substitute "TRANSACTION,
2 INCLUDING A SALE OR TRANSFER CONDUCTED BY THE LICENSEE PURSUANT
3 TO SECTION 18-12-112, 18-12-112.5, OR 18-12-506."

4 Page 7, line 2, before "(4.5)" insert "(2.5) and".

5 Page 8, line 23, after "ON;" add "AND

6 (c) BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2027, THE DEALER HAS IMPLEMENTED
7 SECURITY MEASURES IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE DEPARTMENT'S RULES
8 ADOPTED PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (2.5)(a) OF THIS SECTION AND AS SET
9 FORTH IN THE DEALER'S COMPREHENSIVE SECURITY PLAN SUBMITTED TO
10 THE DEPARTMENT PURSUANT TO SUBSECTION (2.5)(b) OF THIS SECTION.

11 (2.5) (a) ON OR BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2027, THE DEPARTMENT
12 SHALL ADOPT RULES REQUIRING SECURITY MEASURES FOR A DEALER'S
13 PLACE OF BUSINESS TO PROTECT PERSONNEL, CUSTOMERS, FIREARMS, AND
14 AMMUNITION, AND TO PREVENT UNAUTHORIZED ENTRY. THE DEPARTMENT
15 MAY CONSIDER, AND SET DIFFERENT STANDARDS BASED ON, THE
16 CHARACTERISTICS OF A PLACE OF BUSINESS.

17 (b) A DEALER SHALL SUBMIT A COMPREHENSIVE SECURITY PLAN
18 TO THE DEPARTMENT THAT DEMONSTRATES THE SECURITY MEASURES
19 THAT THE DEALER WILL IMPLEMENT TO COMPLY WITH THE RULES ADOPTED
20 PURSUANT TO THIS SUBSECTION (2.5). THE DEPARTMENT MAY PROVIDE
21 FEEDBACK TO A DEALER ON A SUBMITTED PLAN. IF A DEALER UPDATES ITS
22 PLAN AT ANY TIME, THE DEALER SHALL SUBMIT THE UPDATED PLAN TO THE
23 DEPARTMENT."

24 Page 8, strike lines 24 through 27.

25 Page 9, strike lines 1 through 17.

26 Page 9, line 20, strike "SEVENTY-TWO HOURS" and substitute
27 "FORTY-EIGHT HOURS".

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
