## AN ACT CREATING A STAND-YOUR-GROUND LAW.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That title 53a of the general statutes be amended to adopt a standyour-ground policy to allow someone to use force in self-defense when there is reasonable belief of a threat, without an obligation to retreat first, but would require the person standing their ground to (1) have a legal right to be at the location, and (2) not be engaged in an unlawful activity.

## Statement of Purpose:

To allow stand-your-ground self-defense.
