"AN ACT ADDRESSING GUN VIOLENCE."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 54-33b of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2023*):

5 [(a) A law enforcement official may ask a person if he or she may
6 conduct a search of their person, provided such law enforcement official
7 has reasonable and articulable suspicion that weapons, contraband or
8 other evidence of a crime is contained upon the person, or that the
9 search is reasonably necessary to further an ongoing law enforcement
10 investigation. A law enforcement official who solicits consent to search
11 a person shall, whether or not the consent is granted, complete a police
12 report documenting the reasonable and articulable suspicion for the
13 solicitation of consent, or the facts and circumstances that support the
14 search being reasonably necessary to further an ongoing law
15 enforcement investigation.]

16 [(b)] A law enforcement official serving a search warrant may, if such
17 official has reason to believe that any of the property described in the
18 warrant is concealed in the garments of any person in or upon the place
19 or thing to be searched, search the person for the purpose of seizing the
20 same. When the person to be searched is a woman, the search shall be
21 made by a female law enforcement official or other woman assisting in
22 the service of the warrant, or by a woman designated by the judge or
23 judge trial referee issuing the warrant."
