**"AN ACT CONCERNING IMPLEMENTATION OF THE FIREARM
INDUSTRY RESPONSIBILITY ACT, FIREARMS PERMITS AND
ELIGIBILITY CERTIFICATES AND SELF-DEFENSE."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subdivision (2) of subsection (e) of section 54-142a of the
4 general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
5 thereof (*Effective October 1, 2025*):

6 (2) Convictions for the following offenses shall not be eligible for
7 erasure pursuant to this subsection:

8 (A) Any conviction, on or after January 1, 2000, designated as a family
9 violence crime, as defined in section 46b-38a;

10 (B) Any conviction for an offense that is a nonviolent sexual offense
11 or a sexually violent offense, each as defined in section 54-250;

12 (C) Any conviction for a violation of section 29-33, 53a-60a, 53a-60b,
13 53a-60c, 53a-61a, 53a-64bb, 53a-64cc, 53a-72a, 53a-90a, 53a-103a, 53a-
14 181c, 53a-191, 53a-196, 53a-196d, 53a-196f, 53a-211, 53a-212, 53a-216,
15 53a-217, 53a-217a, 53a-217c, 53a-322, 53a-323, 54-251, 54-252, 54-253 or
16 54-254 or subdivision (1) of subsection (a) of section 53a-189a; [or]

17 (D) Any conviction for a violation of section 14-227a if the defendant
18 has been convicted for another violation of section 14-227a within the
19 ten years following such conviction; or

20 (E) Any conviction for an offense committed with a firearm or any
21 other firearm-related offense."
