"AN ACT CONCERNING REVISIONS TO VARIOUS STATUTES CONCERNING CRIMINAL JUSTICE."

Strike section 6 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu
 thereof:

"Sec. 6. Section 54-192h of the general statutes is amended by adding
subsection (h) as follows (*Effective October 1, 2025*):

5 (NEW) (h) A municipality may be subject to an action by any aggrieved person for injunctive or declaratory relief, including a 6 7 determination of past violations, if an officer, employee or other person 8 otherwise paid by or acting as an agent of such municipality's police 9 department or of any school police or security department described in 10 subparagraph (B) or (C) of subdivision (11) of subsection (a) of this 11 section for the school district of such municipality violates any provision 12 of this section. Such action may be brought in the superior court for the 13 judicial district in which the municipality is located. If an aggrieved

14 person or municipality prevails in an action under this subsection, such 15 aggrieved person or municipality may be entitled to recover court costs 16 and reasonable attorney's fees associated only with an action or that 17 portion of an action concerning a request and order for injunctive relief. 18 An action under this subsection shall be privileged with respect to 19 assignment for trial."
