Act 25-424; 71 DCR 3517) ("emergency act"), which expires on June 23, 2024. (b) On March 5, 2024, the Council also passed the Secure DC Omnibus Amendment Act of 2024, enacted on March 11, 2024 (D.C. Act 25-411; 71 DCR 2732) ("permanent act") which has a projected law date of July 23, 2024 and includes the provisions in the emergency act. (c) This emergency legislation is necessary to prevent a gap in the law between the expiration of the emergency act and the effective date of the permanent act.
