Between lines 1189 and 1190, insert:

(8) PANIC BUTTON ALERT SYSTEM.—Subject to appropriation, on or before September 1, 2019, each public school in the state shall have a panic button alert system.

(a) The panic button alert system must:

1. Connect the caller with 911 while simultaneously notifying designated on-site school or administrative personnel.

2. Directly integrate into the existing 911 system.

3. Be available for use through, at a minimum, a smart phone application or a landline telephone. Both callers using a
