2           An act relating to prohibited places for weapons and  
3           firearms; amending s. 790.06, F.S.; authorizing an  
4           elected member of a specified governing body who holds  
5           a license to carry a handgun or a concealed weapon or  
6           firearm to carry a concealed weapon or firearm to a  
7           meeting of the governing body of which he or she is a  
8           member, unless otherwise prohibited by law; providing  
9           an effective date.

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11   Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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13           Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (12) of section  
14   790.06, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

15           790.06 License to carry concealed weapon or firearm.—

16           (12) (a) A license issued under this section does not  
17   authorize any person to openly carry a handgun or carry a  
18   concealed weapon or firearm into:

- 19           1. Any place of nuisance as defined in s. 823.05;  
20           2. Any police, sheriff, or highway patrol station;  
21           3. Any detention facility, prison, or jail;  
22           4. Any courthouse;  
23           5. Any courtroom, except that nothing in this section

24   would preclude a judge from carrying a concealed weapon or  
25   determining who will carry a concealed weapon in his or her

27 |       6. Any polling place;

28 |       7. Any meeting of the governing body of a county, public

29 | school district, municipality, or special district, except that

30 | nothing in this section would preclude an elected member of the

31 | governing body of a county, public school district, or

32 | municipality from carrying a concealed weapon or firearm to a

33 | meeting of the governing body of which he or she is a member,

34 | unless such meeting is held in a location where carrying a

35 | concealed weapon or firearm is otherwise prohibited by law;

36 |       8. Any meeting of the Legislature or a committee thereof;

37 |       9. Any school, college, or professional athletic event not

38 | related to firearms;

39 |       10. Any elementary or secondary school facility or

40 | administration building;

41 |       11. Any career center;

42 |       12. Any portion of an establishment licensed to dispense

43 | alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises, which

44 | portion of the establishment is primarily devoted to such

45 | purpose;

46 |       13. Any college or university facility unless the licensee

47 | is a registered student, employee, or faculty member of such

48 | college or university and the weapon is a stun gun or nonlethal

49 | electric weapon or device designed solely for defensive purposes

50 | and the weapon does not fire a dart or projectile;

51           14. The inside of the passenger terminal and sterile area  
52 of any airport, provided that no person shall be prohibited from  
53 carrying any legal firearm into the terminal, which firearm is  
54 encased for shipment for purposes of checking such firearm as  
55 baggage to be lawfully transported on any aircraft; or

56           15. Any place where the carrying of firearms is prohibited  
57 by federal law.

58           Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
