

Senate Bill 303

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Part 5 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia  
2 Annotated, relating to Brady Law Regulations, so as to require that a gun lock be furnished  
3 to the buyer in all retail firearm sales made by firearm dealers; to provide for criminal  
4 penalties; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 Part 5 of Article 4 of Chapter 11 of Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,  
8 relating to Brady Law Regulations, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as  
9 follows:

10 "16-11-172.1.

11 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'gun lock' means a device that, when installed  
12 on a firearm, is designed to prevent the firearm from being operated without first  
13 deactivating the device.

14 (b) A gun lock shall be furnished by a dealer to the buyer with each retail sale of a firearm  
15 made by such dealer. Any person who violates this Code section shall be guilty of a  
16 misdemeanor."

17 **SECTION 2.**

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
