

HOUSE BILL No. 1221

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 35-47-2.5-4.

Synopsis: Antique firearms. Provides that certain requirements regarding the sale, rental, trade, or transfer of a handgun do not apply to an item defined as an antique firearm.

Effective: July 1, 2026.

HOUSE BILL No. 1221

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning criminal law and procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 35-47-2.5-4, AS AMENDED BY P.L.190-2006,
2 SECTION 8, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2026]: Sec. 4. (a) **This section does not apply to an item**
4 **defined as an antique firearm pursuant to 18 U.S.C. 921(a)(16).**

5 **(b)** A dealer may not sell, rent, trade, or transfer from the dealer's
6 inventory a handgun to a person until the dealer has done all of the
7 following:

8 (1) Obtained from the prospective purchaser a completed and
9 signed Form 4473 as specified in section 3 of this chapter.

10 (2) Contacted NICS:

11 (A) by telephone; or

12 (B) electronically;

13 to request a background check on the prospective purchaser.

14 (3) Received authorization from NICS to transfer the handgun to
15 the prospective purchaser.

16 **(c)** The dealer shall record the NICS transaction number on
17 Form 4473 and retain Form 4473 for auditing purposes.
