SENATE RESOLUTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1 A SENATE RESOLUTION honoring the China
2 Philanthropy Leadership Initiative for its work in improving
3 cross-cultural communication of philanthropy and promoting
4 the development of philanthropy in China.

5 *Whereas, The China Philanthropy Leadership Initiative is*
6 *comprised of students from the IUPUI School of Public and*
7 *Environmental Affairs who have an interest in philanthropy and*
8 *nonprofit organizations;*

9 *Whereas, CPLI's mission is to improve cross-cultural*
10 *communication of philanthropy and promote the development*
11 *of philanthropy in China by creating a platform to engage*
12 *young philanthropic practitioners and scholars, providing*
13 *resources and perspectives to these individuals, and by*
14 *inspiring practices and leadership through Chinese and*
15 *American experiences;*

16 *Whereas, Providing over 10 seminars focused on Chinese*
17 *topics, philanthropy, and civil society, CPLI invited guest*
18 *speakers from the International Center, Tabernacle*
19 *Presbyterian Church, RESULTS Global Grassroots Associate,*
20 *and the Sister Cities of Louisville;*



1 *Whereas, Recently CPLI worked with the Chinese*
2 *Nonprofit Study Association to launch a translation project*
3 *funded by Philanthropy Weekly, introducing thought-provoking*
4 *articles produced by the Chronicle of Philanthropy and other*
5 *American mainstream newspapers and magazines for a Chinese*
6 *speaking audience, to help Chinese practitioners understand*
7 *American philanthropy and to become inspired by great ideas*
8 *and practices in other countries; and*

9 *Whereas, CPLI's efforts and goals help bring together*
10 *students and cultures and will lead to the realization of the*
11 *organization's philanthropic vision of implementing the*
12 *practices learned through CPLI in China: Therefore,*

13 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the*
14 *General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

15 SECTION 1. That the Indiana Senate honors the China
16 Philanthropy Leadership Initiative for its work in improving
17 cross-cultural communication in philanthropy and promoting
18 the development of philanthropy in China.

19 SECTION 2. The Secretary of the Senate is hereby directed
20 to transmit copies of this Resolution to all members of the
