DIGEST

Health profession education program. Provides that a student enrolled in a health profession education program may not be required to receive an immunization as a condition of: (1) participating in; or (2) obtaining; clinical training or clinical experience required by the program if receiving the immunization is against the student's conscience.

- 1 Page 141, between lines 17 and 18, begin a new paragraph and

6 **Chapter 10. Health Profession Education Program**
7 **Sec. 1. This chapter does not apply to a contract entered into or**
8 **renewed before July 1, 2026.**
9 **Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "health profession education**
10 **program" means an education program that:**
11 **(1) is designed to prepare a student for a career in a health**
12 **profession regulated by an entity described in IC 25-0.5-11;**
13 **and**
14 **(2) requires a student to complete clinical training or clinical**
15 **experience at an offsite facility.**
16 **Sec. 3. As used in this chapter, "immunization" means the**
17 **treatment of an individual with a vaccine to produce immunity.**
18 **Sec. 4. As used in this chapter, "student" means a student**
19 **enrolled in a health profession education program.**
20 **Sec. 5. A student may not be required to receive an**
21 **immunization as a condition of:**
22 **(1) participating in; or**
23 **(2) obtaining;**
24 **clinical training or clinical experience required by a health**
25 **profession education program if receiving the immunization is**
26 **against the student's conscience."**
