1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend Michael Joseph Ducrest for achieving the rank of Eagle Scout of Boy Scouts
3 of America.

4 WHEREAS, Michael Ducrest is to be commended for achieving the rank of Eagle
5 Scout of Boy Scouts of America Troop 55 at the age of thirteen; and

6 WHEREAS, the mission of the Boy Scouts of America, incorporated on February
7 8, 1910, and chartered by the United States Congress in 1916, is to provide an educational
8 program for boys and young men to build character, train in the responsibilities of being a
9 participatory citizen, and develop physical fitness and wellness; and

10 WHEREAS, to earn the rank of Eagle Scout, the highest rank in scouting, a Boy
11 Scout must fulfill all requirements in the areas of leadership, service, and outdoor
12 proficiencies; the scout must earn at least twenty-one merit badges to signify the mastery of
13 Scoutcraft skills that include Citizenship in the Community, Citizenship in the Nation, and
14 Citizenship in the World; and

15 WHEREAS, with scouting and other life endeavors, Michael Ducrest has
16 demonstrated natural abilities as a mentor and role model; he is a mentor to his fellow scouts
17 and role model to his older brother Matthew, who also achieved the rank of Eagle Scout at
18 the age of thirteen; and
