HOUSE AMENDMENT “ ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to H.P. 1491, L.D. 2212, “An Act Making Supplemental Appropriations and Allocations from the General Fund and Other Funds for the Expenditures of State Government and Changing Certain Provisions of the Law Necessary to the Proper Operations of State Government for the Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 2026 and June 30, 2027”

Amend the amendment in Part QQQ in section 1 in §12723 in subsection 2 in paragraph C in the last line (page 194, line 37 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and"

Amend the amendment in Part QQQ in section 1 in §12723 in subsection 2 in paragraph D in the last line (page 194, line 39 in amendment) by striking out the following: " ." and inserting the following: '; and'

Amend the amendment in Part QQQ in section 1 in §12723 in subsection 2 by inserting after paragraph D the following:

'E. Be a graduate of a high school or an equivalent program in this State.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment requires a person to be a graduate of a high school or an equivalent program in this State to be eligible for the Maine Free Community College Program.
