A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Handgun Qualification License – Firearms Safety Training**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing a requirement to obtain a certain handgun qualification
4 license that a certain firearms safety training course include a certain firearms
5 orientation component; and generally relating to handgun qualification licenses.

6 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

7 Article – Public Safety

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Public Safety**

14 5–117.1.

15 (d) Subject to subsections (f) and (g) of this section, the Secretary shall issue a
16 handgun qualification license to a person who the Secretary finds:

17 (1) is at least 21 years old;

18 (2) is a resident of the State;

19 (3) except as provided in subsection (e) of this section, has demonstrated
20 satisfactory completion, within 3 years prior to the submission of the application, of a
21 firearms safety training course approved by the Secretary that includes:

1 (i) a minimum of 4 hours of instruction by a qualified handgun
2 instructor; **AND**

3 (ii) classroom instruction on:

4 1. State firearm law;

5 2. home firearm safety; and

6 3. handgun mechanisms and operation; and

7 [(iii) a firearms orientation component that demonstrates the person's
8 safe operation and handling of a firearm; and]

9 (4) based on an investigation, is not prohibited by federal or State law from
10 purchasing or possessing a handgun.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 October 1, 2021.
