1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore County – Education – Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps**
3 **Instructors**

4 FOR the purpose of applying to Baltimore County a certain definition of “public school
5 employee” that includes Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) instructors
6 for the purpose of certain provisions of law related to organizations of certificated
7 employees; and generally relating to representation for JROTC instructors in
8 Baltimore County.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
10 Article – Education
11 Section 6–401(e)
12 Annotated Code of Maryland
13 (2014 Replacement Volume and 2014 Supplement)

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
15 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article – Education**

17 6–401.

18 (e) (1) “Public school employee” means a certificated professional individual
19 who is employed by a public school employer or an individual of equivalent status in

1 Baltimore City, except for a county superintendent or an individual designated by the
2 public school employer to act in a negotiating capacity as provided in § 6–408(c) of this
3 subtitle.

4 (2) In Montgomery County, “public school employees” include:

5 (i) Certificated and noncertificated substitute teachers employed by
6 the public school employer for at least 7 days before March 1 of the school fiscal year ending
7 June 30, 1978, and each year after; and

8 (ii) Home and hospital teachers employed by the public school
9 employer for at least 7 days before March 1 of the school fiscal year ending June 30, 2000,
10 and each year after.

11 (3) In Baltimore County, “public school employee” includes a secondary
12 school nurse, an elementary school nurse, and a special school nurse.

13 (4) In Frederick County, “public school employee” includes a social worker
14 employed by a public school employer.

15 (5) In Prince George’s County, “public school employee” includes home and
16 hospital teachers and Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps (JROTC) instructors.

17 (6) In **BALTIMORE COUNTY**, Calvert County, Charles County, and
18 Garrett County, “public school employee” includes Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps
19 (JROTC) instructors.

20 (7) In Carroll County, “public school employee” includes:

21 (i) A registered nurse; and

22 (ii) Supervisory noncertificated employees as defined under §
23 6–501(i) of this title.

24 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
25 1, 2015.
