A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Firearms – Right to Purchase, Own, Possess, and Carry**

3 FOR the purpose of providing that a person may not be denied the right to purchase, own,
4 possess, or carry a firearm solely on the basis that the person is authorized to use
5 medical cannabis; and generally relating to firearms.

6 BY adding to

7 Article – Public Safety

8 Section 5–901 to be under the new subtitle “Subtitle 9. Miscellaneous”

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
12 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Public Safety**

14 **SUBTITLE 9. MISCELLANEOUS.**

15 **5–901.**

16 **A PERSON MAY NOT BE DENIED THE RIGHT TO PURCHASE, OWN, POSSESS, OR**
17 **CARRY A FIREARM UNDER THIS TITLE SOLELY ON THE BASIS THAT THE PERSON IS**
18 **AUTHORIZED TO USE MEDICAL CANNABIS UNDER TITLE 36, SUBTITLE 3 OF THE**
19 **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AND CANNABIS ARTICLE.**

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 2025.
