2 **Task Force to Study Access of Individuals with Mental Illness to Regulated**
3 **Firearms – Extension**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the date by which the Task Force is required to Study
5 Access of Individuals with Mental Illness to Regulated Firearms is required to
6 submit certain findings and recommendations; extending the termination date
7 of the Task Force; and generally relating to the Task Force to Study Access of
8 Individuals with Mental Illness to Regulated Firearms.

9 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
10 Chapter 131 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2012
11 Section 1(g) and 2

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Chapter 131 of the Acts of 2012**

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That:

17 (g) On or before December [31, 2012] **1, 2013**, the Task Force shall report its
18 findings and recommendations, including recommendations regarding legislative
19 options, to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government
20 Article, the General Assembly.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 2 June 1, 2012. It shall remain effective for a period of [1 year] **2 YEARS AND 1 MONTH**
 3 and, at the end of [May 31, 2013] **JUNE 30, 2014**, with no further action required by
 4 the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 6 June 1, 2013.
