An Act relative to firearm identification cards.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 129B of chapter 140 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 173, the words “a period of 90 days” and
3 inserting in place thereof the following words:- an indefinite period.
