8 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to firearms; amending 21 O.S. 2011,
11 Section 1289.6, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter
12 268, O.S.L. 2016 (21 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section
13 1289.6), which relates to the Oklahoma Firearms Act
14 of 1971; clarifying manner in which loaded and
15 unloaded firearms may be carried without a license;
16 and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2011, Section 1289.6, as
19 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 268, O.S.L. 2016 (21 O.S. Supp.
20 2017, Section 1289.6), is amended to read as follows:

21 Section 1289.6

22 CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH FIREARMS MAY BE CARRIED

23 A. A person shall be permitted to carry loaded and unloaded
24 shotguns, rifles and pistols, ~~open and not concealed~~ and without a
handgun license as authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act
pursuant to the following conditions:

- 1 1. When hunting animals or fowl;
- 2 2. During competition in or practicing in a safety or hunter
3 safety class, target shooting, skeet, trap or other recognized
4 sporting events;
- 5 3. During participation in or in preparation for a military
6 function of the state military forces to be defined as the Oklahoma
7 Army or Air National Guard, Federal Military Reserve and active
8 military forces. It is further provided that Oklahoma Army or Air
9 National Guard personnel with proper authorization and performing a
10 military function may carry loaded or unloaded and concealed weapons
11 on Oklahoma Military Department facilities in accordance with rules
12 promulgated by the Adjutant General;
- 13 4. During participation in or in preparation for a recognized
14 police function of either a municipal, county or state government as
15 functioning police officials;
- 16 5. During a practice for or a performance for entertainment
17 purposes;
- 18 6. For lawful self-defense and self-protection or any other
19 legitimate purpose in or on property that is owned, leased, rented,
20 or otherwise legally controlled by ~~the~~ a person; or
- 21 7. For any legitimate purpose not in violation of the Oklahoma
22 Firearms Act of 1971 or any legislative enactment regarding the use,
23 ownership and control of firearms.

1 B. A person shall be permitted to carry unloaded shotguns,
2 rifles and pistols, ~~open and not concealed~~ and without a handgun
3 license as authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act pursuant to
4 the following conditions:

5 1. When going to or from the person's private residence or
6 vehicle or a vehicle in which the person is riding as a passenger to
7 a place designated or authorized for firearms repairs or
8 reconditioning, or for firearms trade, sale, or barter, or gunsmith,
9 or hunting animals or fowl, or hunter safety course, or target
10 shooting, or skeet or trap shooting or any recognized firearms
11 activity or event and while in such places; or

12 2. For any legitimate purpose not in violation of the Oklahoma
13 Firearms Act of 1971.

14 C. The provisions of this section shall not be construed to
15 prohibit educational or recreational activities, exhibitions,
16 displays or shows involving the use or display of rifles, shotguns
17 or pistols or other weapons if the activity is approved by the
18 property owner and sponsor of the activity.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
