9 An Act relating to firearms; amending 21 O.S. 2021,  
10 Section 1289.13A, which relates to the improper  
11 transportation of firearms; clarifying scope of  
12 certain unlawful act; and providing an effective  
13 date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1289.13A, is  
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 1289.13A

18 IMPROPER TRANSPORTATION OF FIREARMS

19 A. Any person stopped pursuant to a moving traffic violation  
20 who is transporting a firearm in or on the vehicle ~~as authorized by~~  
21 ~~the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act or using a valid license from another~~  
22 ~~state and is~~ in violation of any law related to the carrying or  
23 transporting of firearms in the vehicle, may be issued a traffic  
24 citation in the amount of Seventy Dollars (\$70.00), plus court costs

1 for transporting a firearm improperly. In addition to the traffic  
2 citation provided in this section, the person may also be arrested  
3 for any other violation of law.

4 B. Any firearm lawfully carried or transported as permitted  
5 pursuant to state law shall not be confiscated, unless:

6 1. The person is arrested for violating another provision of  
7 law other than a violation of subsection A of this section;  
8 provided, however, if the person is never charged with an offense  
9 pursuant to this paragraph or if the charges are dismissed or the  
10 person is acquitted, the weapon and ammunition shall be returned to  
11 the person; or

12 2. The officer has probable cause to believe the weapon is:  
13 a. contraband, or  
14 b. a firearm used in the commission of a crime other than  
15 a violation of subsection A of this section.

16 C. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require  
17 confiscation of any firearm.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
