9 FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

10 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act;
11 amending 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1290.2, which relates
12 to certain definitions; modifying definitions for
13 concealed and unconcealed firearms; providing
14 exceptions; defining terms; and providing an
15 effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2021, Section 1290.2, is
18 amended to read as follows:

19 Section 1290.2.

20 DEFINITIONS

21 A. As used in the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act:

22 1. "Completed application" means all fields are completed, all
23 questions are answered and the required signatures are present on
24 the application for a handgun license, and the required documents

1 are attached to the application, including legible fingerprints, if
2 applicable;

3 2. "Concealed ~~handgun~~ firearm" means a loaded or unloaded
4 ~~pistol or handgun~~ firearm not openly visible to the ordinary
5 observation of a reasonable person;

6 3. "Unconcealed ~~handgun~~ firearm" or "open carry" means a loaded
7 or unloaded ~~pistol or handgun~~ firearm that is not held in the hand,
8 but rather is carried upon the person in a holster where the firearm
9 is visible, or carried upon the person using a scabbard, or on a
10 shouldered sling with the firearm located in a general vertical
11 position where the barrel of the firearm is safely pointed in an up
12 or down direction, or in a case designed for carrying firearms. The
13 provisions of this paragraph shall not apply while lawfully at a gun
14 range, while lawfully hunting, during an act of self-defense, or
15 otherwise during lawful use of the firearm; and

16 4. "Pistol" or "handgun" shall have the same definition as
17 provided in the Oklahoma Firearms Act of 1971, defined in Section
18 1289.3 of this title;

19 5. "Rifle" shall have the same definition as provided in
20 Section 1289.4 of this title; and

21 6. "Shotgun" shall have the same definition as provided in
22 Section 1289.5 of this title.

1 B. The definition of pistol or handgun for purposes of the
2 Oklahoma Self-Defense Act shall not apply to imitation pistols,
3 flare guns, underwater fishing guns or blank pistols.

4 C. Pistols, handguns, rifles, shotguns, and all other lawful
5 firearms mentioned in the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act may collectively
6 be referred to as "firearms".

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
