



1 any vehicle which the person is operating, or at the residence where  
2 the convicted person resides, any pistol, imitation or homemade  
3 pistol, altered air or toy pistol, machine gun, sawed-off shotgun or  
4 sawed-off rifle, or any other firearm.

5 B. Any person who has previously been convicted of a nonviolent  
6 felony in any court of this state or of another state or of the  
7 United States, and who has received a full and complete pardon from  
8 the proper authority and has not been convicted of any other felony  
9 offense which has not been pardoned, shall have restored the right  
10 to possess any firearm or other weapon prohibited by subsection A of  
11 this section, the right to apply for and carry a handgun, concealed  
12 or unconcealed, pursuant to the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-  
13 Defense Act or as otherwise permitted by law, and have the right to  
14 perform the duties of a peace officer, gunsmith, and for firearms  
15 repair.

16 C. It shall be unlawful for any person serving a term of  
17 probation for any felony in any court of this state or of another  
18 state or of the United States or under the jurisdiction of any  
19 alternative court program to have in his or her possession or under  
20 his or her immediate control, or at his or her residence, or in any  
21 passenger vehicle which the person is operating, any pistol, shotgun  
22 or rifle including any imitation or homemade pistol, altered air or  
23 toy pistol, toy shotgun or toy rifle, while such person is subject  
24 to supervision, probation, parole or inmate status.

1 D. It shall be unlawful for any person previously adjudicated  
2 as a delinquent child or a youthful offender for the commission of  
3 an offense, which would have constituted a felony offense if  
4 committed by an adult, to have in the possession of the person or  
5 under the immediate control of the person, or have in any vehicle  
6 which he or she is driving, or at the residence of the person, any  
7 pistol, imitation or homemade pistol, altered air or toy pistol,  
8 machine gun, sawed-off shotgun or sawed-off rifle, or any other  
9 dangerous or deadly firearm within ten (10) years after such  
10 adjudication; provided, that nothing in this subsection shall be  
11 construed to prohibit the placement of the person in a home with a  
12 full-time duly appointed peace officer who is certified by the  
13 Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET) pursuant  
14 to the provisions of Section 3311 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma  
15 Statutes.

16 E. It shall be unlawful for any person who is an alien  
17 illegally or unlawfully in the United States to have in the  
18 possession of the person or under the immediate control of the  
19 person, or in any vehicle the person is operating, or at the  
20 residence where the person resides, any pistol, imitation or  
21 homemade pistol, altered air or toy pistol, shotgun, rifle or any  
22 other dangerous or deadly firearm; provided, that nothing in this  
23 subsection applies to prohibit the transport or detention of the  
24 person by law enforcement officers or federal immigration

1 authorities. Any person who violates the provisions of this  
2 subsection shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a misdemeanor  
3 punishable by a fine of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).

4 F. Any person having been issued a handgun license pursuant to  
5 the provisions of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act and who knowingly or  
6 intentionally allows a convicted felon or adjudicated delinquent or  
7 a youthful offender as prohibited by the provisions of subsection A,  
8 C, or D of this section to possess or have control of any firearm  
9 authorized by the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act shall, upon conviction,  
10 be guilty of a felony punishable by a fine not to exceed Five  
11 Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00). In addition, the person shall have  
12 the handgun license revoked by the Oklahoma State Bureau of  
13 Investigation after a hearing and determination that the person has  
14 violated the provisions of this section.

15 G. Any convicted or adjudicated person violating the provisions  
16 of this section shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony  
17 punishable as provided in Section 1284 of this title.

18 H. For purposes of this section, ~~"sawed-off shotgun":~~

19 1. "Sawed-off shotgun" or "sawed-off rifle" shall mean any  
20 shotgun or rifle which the barrel or barrels have been illegally  
21 shortened in length-

22 ~~I. For purposes of this section, "altered toy pistol";~~

1        2. "Altered toy pistol" shall mean any toy weapon which has  
2 been altered from its original manufactured state to resemble a real  
3 weapon.

4        ~~J. For purposes of this section, "altered air pistol";~~

5        3. "Altered air pistol" shall mean any air pistol manufactured  
6 to propel projectiles by air pressure which has been altered from  
7 its original manufactured state.

8        ~~K. For purposes of this section, "alternative court program";~~

9        4. "Alternative court program" shall mean any drug court, Anna  
10 McBride or mental health court, DUI court or veterans court; and

11        5. "Imitation pistol" shall mean any pistol capable of raising  
12 in the mind of the one threatened with such device a fear that it is  
13 a real pistol.

14        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
