CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to firearms in public buildings; amending ORS 166.380.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. ORS 166.380 is amended to read:

166.380. (1) **Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section,** a peace officer may examine a firearm possessed by anyone on the person while in or on a public building to determine whether the firearm is a loaded firearm.

(2) A person who is licensed under ORS 166.291 and 166.292 to carry a concealed handgun may present a valid concealed handgun license to the peace officer instead of providing the firearm to the peace officer for examination.

[(2) Refusal by a person to allow the examination authorized by subsection (1) of this section constitutes reason to believe that the person has committed a crime and the peace officer may make an arrest pursuant to ORS 133.310.]
