1 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 12 and 13, by striking out "The
2 license shall be in accordance with" and inserting

3 The issuance of a license shall be subject to

7 (1) The license may be issued to a nonresident who meets
8 either of the following:

9 (i) The nonresident was born in this Commonwealth.

10 (ii) The nonresident has a living parent or former
11 guardian who resides in this Commonwealth.

12 (2) The license shall cost the same as a resident
13 license under section 2709 (relating to license costs and
14 fees).

15 (3) An applicant must provide a current photo
16 identification card and the applicable documentation under
17 one of the following:

18 (i) For an applicant who qualifies under paragraph

19 (1)(i), either of the following:

20 (A) A certified copy of the applicant's original
21 birth certificate showing that the applicant was born
22 in this Commonwealth or that the applicant's parent's
23 address was in this Commonwealth at the time of the
24 applicant's birth.

25 (B) A written affirmation that the applicant was
26 born in this Commonwealth.

27 (ii) For an applicant who qualifies under paragraph
28 (1)(ii), proof of the living parent or former guardian's
29 address within this Commonwealth.

30 (4) A first-time applicant for a Native Pennsylvanian
31 annual license must submit the application to the commission.

32 (5) A Native Pennsylvanian annual license shall be
33 identical to an annual resident license sold by the
34 commission and shall be properly designated "Native
35 Pennsylvanian."

1 (6) All regular annual licenses offered to residents
2 shall be made available to an applicant who qualifies as a
3 Native Pennsylvanian. This paragraph shall not apply to a
4 lifetime license.

5 (7) Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to
6 limit eligibility for a resident hunter's license under
7 subsection (b).

8 (8) An applicant who provides a false written
9 affirmation under paragraph (3)(i)(B) shall be subject to
10 section 2711(a)(2) and (b)(3) (relating to unlawful acts
11 concerning licenses) and 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904 (relating to
12 unsworn falsification to authorities).
