

AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 1313

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1 Amend Bill, page 1, lines 1 through 19; pages 2 and 3, lines
2 1 through 30; page 4, lines 1 through 19; by striking out all of
3 said lines on said pages and inserting

4 Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
5 Statutes, in hunting and furtaking licenses, providing for
6 Native Pennsylvanian Annual License; and imposing penalties.
7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby
8 enacts as follows:

9 Section 1. Title 34 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
10 Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:

11 § 2703.1. Native Pennsylvanian Annual License.

12 (a) Issuance.--The commission shall issue an annual
13 Pennsylvania hunting license, known as the Native Pennsylvanian
14 Annual License, subject to the following:

15 (1) The license may be issued to a nonresident who:

16 (i) was born in this Commonwealth; or

17 (ii) previously resided in this Commonwealth.

18 (2) The license shall cost \$30 for a period of five days
19 and shall be valid only during the deer regular firearms
20 season.

21 (3) An applicant for the license must provide a current
22 photo identification card and the following applicable
23 documentation:

24 (i) If the applicant qualifies under paragraph (1)

25 (i), a written affirmation that the applicant was born in
26 this Commonwealth.

27 (ii) If the applicant qualifies under paragraph (1)

28 (ii), proof of the applicant's former residency in this
29 Commonwealth.

30 (4) A first-time applicant for the license must submit
31 the application to the commission.

32 (5) The license shall be properly designated "Native
33 Pennsylvanian."

34 (b) Construction.--Nothing in this section shall be
35 construed to limit eligibility for a resident hunter's license
36 under section 2702(b) (relating to residents).

37 (c) Penalties.--If an applicant for a license under this

1 section provides a false written affirmation under subsection
2 (a)(3)(i), the applicant shall be subject to section 2711(a)(2)
3 and (b)(3) (relating to unlawful acts concerning licenses) and
4 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904 (relating to unsworn falsification to
5 authorities).

6 Section 2. The addition of 34 Pa.C.S. § 2703.1 shall apply
7 to the 2027-2028 deer regular firearms season and each deer
8 regular firearms season thereafter.

9 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
