## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 1 2 Consolidated Statutes, in minors, further providing for the 3 offense of corruption of minors. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 6301(a) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 8 § 6301. Corruption of minors. 9 Offense defined .--(a) 10 (1)Except as provided in subparagraph (ii), 11 whoever, being of the age of 18 years and upwards, by any 12 act corrupts or tends to corrupt the morals of any minor 13 less than 18 years of age, or who aids, abets, entices or encourages any such minor in the commission of any crime, 14 15 or who knowingly assists or encourages such minor in 16 violating his or her parole or any order of court, 17 commits a misdemeanor of the first degree.

Whoever, being of the age of 18 years and

upwards, by any course of conduct in violation of Chapter
31 (relating to sexual offenses) corrupts or tends to
corrupt the morals of any minor less than 18 years of
age, or who aids, abets, entices or encourages any such
minor in the commission of an offense under Chapter 31
commits a felony of the third degree.

- (2) [Any person who knowingly aids, abets, entices or encourages a minor younger than 18 years of age to commit truancy commits a summary offense. Any person who violates this paragraph within one year of the date of a first conviction under this section commits a misdemeanor of the third degree. A conviction under this paragraph shall not, however, constitute a prohibition under section 6105 (relating to persons not to possess, use, manufacture, control, sell or transfer firearms).] (Reserved).
- 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
