It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 11-47-5.2 of the General Laws in Chapter 11-47 entitled
 "Weapons" is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 3 <u>11-47-5.2. Possession of a stolen firearm. --</u> It shall be unlawful for any person to
- 4 possess a stolen firearm, knowing it to be stolen. Any person in violation of this section shall be
- 5 guilty of a felony and subject to imprisonment shall be imprisoned for not less than three (3)
- 6 years nor more than fifteen (15) years, and shall not be afforded the benefit of suspension or
- 7 <u>deferment of sentence, nor of probation</u>.
- 8 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
