It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

2 by adding thereto the following section: 3 11-47-63. Prohibition of possession of explosive materials. - (a) Any person who is 4 prohibited from possessing a firearm shall be prohibited from the possession of explosive 5 materials as defined in 27 CFR 555.23 – List of explosive materials. Any license or permit, issued to a person so prohibited to conduct blasting operations or conduct displays of fireworks or 6 7 pyrotechnics shall be immediately revoked or suspended for the duration of the prohibition to 8 possess firearms. 9 (b) Every person who violates the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction, be 10 punished by imprisonment of not more than five (5) years, or a fine of not more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000), or both. 11

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
