A BILL

To amend chapter 44 of title 18, United States Code, to prohibit the sale or other disposition of a firearm to, and the possession, shipment, transportation, or receipt of a firearm by, certain classes of high-risk individuals.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FIREARM PROHIBITIONS APPLICABLE WITH**
4 **RESPECT TO CERTAIN HIGH-RISK INDIVID-**
5 **UALS.**

6 (a) SALES OR OTHER DISPOSITIONS.—Section
7 922(d) of title 18, United States Code, is amended in the
8 1st sentence—

1 (1) by striking “or” at the end of paragraph
2 (8);

3 (2) by striking the period at the end of para-
4 graph (9) and inserting a semicolon; and

5 (3) by adding at the end the following:

6 “(10) in the most recent 10-year period, has
7 been convicted in any court of a crime of violence
8 (as defined in section 16);

9 “(11) has not attained 25 years of age, and has
10 been adjudicated by any court as having committed
11 an offense that would have been a crime of violence
12 (as defined in section 16) if committed by an adult;

13 “(12) in any period of 3 consecutive years in
14 the most recent 10-year period, has been convicted
15 in any court, on 2 separate occasions, of an offense
16 that has, as an element, the possession or distribu-
17 tion of, or the intent to possess or distribute, alcohol
18 or a controlled substance (as so defined); or

19 “(13) has been convicted in any court of stalk-
20 ing.”.

21 (b) POSSESSION, SHIPMENT, TRANSPORTATION, OR
22 RECEIPT.—Section 922(g) of such title is amended—

23 (1) by striking “or” at the end of paragraph
24 (8);

1 (2) by striking the comma at the end of para-
2 graph (9) and inserting a semicolon; and

3 (3) by inserting after paragraph (9) the fol-
4 lowing:

5 “(10) who, in the most recent 10-year period,
6 has been convicted in any court of a crime of vio-
7 lence (as defined in section 16);

8 “(11) who has not attained 25 years of age and
9 has been adjudicated by any court as having com-
10 mitted an offense that would have been a crime of
11 violence (as defined in section 16) if committed by
12 an adult;

13 “(12) who, in any period of 3 consecutive years
14 in the most recent 10-year period, has been con-
15 victed in any court, on 2 separate occasions, of an
16 offense that has, as an element, the possession or
17 distribution of, or the intent to possess or distribute,
18 alcohol or a controlled substance (as so defined); or

19 “(13) who has been convicted in any court of
20 stalking.”.
