3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF THE FIREARMS TRANSFER**

4 **WAITING PERIOD.**

5 Section 922(t)(1)(B)(ii) of title 18 United States
6 Code, is amended by striking “3” and inserting “14”.

1 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 The amendment made by this Act shall take effect

3 90 days after the date of the enactment of this Act.
