## A BILL

To protect the right of individuals to bear arms at water resources development projects.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROTECTING THE RIGHT OF INDIVIDUALS TO**  
4 **BEAR ARMS AT WATER RESOURCES DEVEL-**  
5 **OPMENT PROJECTS.**

6 The Secretary of the Army shall not promulgate or  
7 enforce any regulation that prohibits an individual from  
8 possessing a firearm, including an assembled or functional  
9 firearm, in any area open to the public (other than a Fed-  
10 eral facility as defined in section 930(g) of title 18, United

1 States Code) at a water resources development project  
2 covered under section 327.0 of title 36, Code of Federal  
3 Regulations (as in effect on the date of enactment of this  
4 Act), if—

5           (1) the individual is not otherwise prohibited by  
6           law from possessing the firearm; and

7           (2) the possession of the firearm is in compli-  
8           ance with the law of the State in which the water  
9           resources development project is located.
