A BILL

To prohibit firearms dealers from selling a firearm prior to the completion of a background check.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Background Check
5 Completion Act of 2017”.

6 **SEC. 2. COMPLETION OF BACKGROUND CHECKS.**

7 Section 922(t)(1)(B) of title 18, United States Code,
8 is amended—

1 (1) by striking “(i)”;

2 (2) by striking “; or” and inserting “; and”;

3 and

4 (3) by striking clause (ii).
