Representative **A. Cory Maloy** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Line 71 through 82:*

- 71 residence in this state as required under this Subsection (1).
- 72 (2) (a) A criminal history background check is required for the sale of a firearm by a
- 73 licensed firearm dealer in the state.
- 74 (b) Subsection (2)(a) does not apply to the sale or transfer { ~~of a firearm to~~ } of:
- 75 (i) [-]a firearm to a Federal Firearms Licensee[-]; or

- application for the sale or transfer of

- 81 criminal background check, on a form provided by the bureau.
